44: 2 how Thou didst drive out the heathen with Thy hand, and planted them; how Thou didst afflict the people, and cast them out. 3 For they got not the land in possession by their own sword, neither did their own arm save them, but by Thy right hand and Thine arm and the light of Thy countenance, because Thou hadst favor unto them. 4 Thou art my King, O God; command deliverances for Jacob. 5 Through Thee will we push down our enemies; through Thy name will we tread them under that rise up against us. 6 For I will not trust in my bow, neither shall my sword save me, 7 but Thou hast saved us from our enemies, and hast put them to shame that hated us.

- You are our hiding place, You shall preserve us from trouble, You shall compass us about with songs of deliverance. Behold, the eye of the Lord is upon we who fear Him, upon we who hope in His mercy to deliver our souls from death, and to keep us alive in famine. Our soul waits for the Lord, He is our help and our shield.
- The Lord redeems the soul of His servants, and none of them that trust in Him shall be desolate. He has brought us up also out of a horrible pit, out of the miry clay, and set our feet upon a rock and established our goings. O send out Your light and Your truth! Let them lead us. Let them bring us unto Your holy hill and to Your tabernacles.
- Drive out every principality, every power, every ruler of the darkness of this world, every spiritual wickedness in any high place with Your Hand, and cast them out. You are our King, O God, command deliverances for us. Through You will we push down our enemies, through Your Name will we tread them under that rise up against us. For we will not trust in our bow, neither shall our sword save us but You have saved us from our enemies, and have put them to shame that hated us.
